CITY ORDINANCE NO. 001 S. 2011

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED LIMIT AND LOADING CAPACITY FOR PUBLIC/PRIVATE VEHICLE IN THE CITY OF BAYBAY OTHERWISE KNOWN AS ROAD SAFETY ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Baybay, Province of Leyte in session assembled that:

SECTION I.- Title:- This ordinance shall be called the Road Safety Ordinance.

SECTION II.- Definition of Terms.- The following terms used shall be define as follows:

- Driver small mean any person who manned any vehicle using and or a.passing through the road;
- b.-Road - The lane usually provided for any vehicle to go somewhere whether cemented, asphalted and or gravel road;
- C.-Vehicle - shall mean, any kind of engine-driven land transportation used to carry people or goods from one place to another;
 - 1. Bus a large public/private passenger vehicle serging fixed routes.
 - 2. Truck a strong or heavy vehicle used to carry heavy loads or cargoes or any heavy materials.
 - 3. Van a close, small public/private vehicle with two passengers setting beside the driver.
 - 4. Jeepney means a small public/private vehicle with two (2) allowable passengers sitting beside the driver and a maximum sitting capacity at the back with open door
 - 5. Tricycle a motorcycle with sidecar used to carry three (3) maximum passengers in front beside the driver and four (4) riding at the back of the driver.
 - 6. Multicab a small mini public/private car usually or 4 wheeled with one authorized passenger sitting in front beside the driver and a sitting capacity is required at the back.

- d.- Passenger The riding people of any public/private vehicle whether they pay their fare or not.
- e.- Accessories shall mean the horn, brake, headlights, brake lights, turn signal lights, side mirrors, wiper, etc.;
- f.- Temporary Operator's Permit shall mean the citation tickets issue by the LTO deputized agents to those who violate these Rules and Regulations.

SECTION III.- Speed limit - is the allowable maximum speed required while the vehicle is running on the road at a careful and prudent speed not to endanger the life of any persons.

SECTION IV.- Miscellaneous Traffic Rules

- No driver shall operate while under the influence of liquor.
- b. the driver shall not use cellular phone or other gadgets while operating/
- c. The driver shall observe traffic signs at the corner of the streets..

SECTION V. - Registration of Vehicles - all vehicles used or operating in any place must be registered with the Land Transportation Office for the current year in accordance with R.A. # 4136 as amended.

SECTION VI. - Use of Number Plates - every vehicle shall at all time display in conspicuous place of the car in front and the rear view the reflective number plates issued by the Land Transportation Office (LTO).

SECTION VII.- Duty of the Driver.

a. - To have a license except as otherwise specifically provided by law, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle without a valid license to drive.

- b. All public utility drivers are required to observe sitting capacity in loading and transporting passengers.
- c. Driver should not wear, sandal, slippers or being barefooted while driving vehicle. Motorcycle driver and passengers should wear helmet at all times.

SECTION VIII. - Penal and other Provisions.- the following fines/penalties shall be imposed against those who violated the rules and regulations stipulated under this ordinance.

- a. For any defective accessories mentioned under Sec. II Paragraph (e) a fine of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00)
- b.- For the drivers caught under the influence of liquor, a fine of **ONE THOUSAND**FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P1,500.00)
- c.- For the driver caught violating Section iii (speed limit) of this Ordinance shall be imposed a fine of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00)**
- d.- Violations of any provisions defined in Sec. Vii of this ordinance, the driver shall be imposed a fine of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00)**
- e.- Overloading of cargoes and passengers shall be imposed a fine of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00).**

SECTION IX.- Separability Clause. - If any portion or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, it will not invalidate the whole ordinance.

SECTION X. - Repealing Clause - all existing Ordinance, rules and regulations which are inconsistent to this ordinance are hereby repealed, amend or modified.

SECTION XI.- Effectivity. - this ordinance will take effect 15 days after its approval fro the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

ENACTED, January 17, 2011

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to let certified copies of this ordinance be furnished to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte for their information and appropriate action.
