AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO.001 S. 2007, ESTABLISHING THE LINE ROUTE OF ALL PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF BAYBAY PARTICULARLY SECTION 3, PARAGRAPHS A; D.d.1; E.e.1; and F.f.1.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Baybay City in session, that:

SECTION 1- Title

This Ordinance shall be called the Line Route Ordinance for all Public Utility Vehicles within the Poblacion of Baybay City.

SECTION 2 - Definition of terms-. The following terms shall be defined as:

- a. Public utility vehicle all motorized vehicle carrying cargoes and passengers offered to the public.
- b. Passengers the riding public of public utility vehicle, whether they pay their fare or not;

SECTION 3 - The line route as designated by this proposed ordinance are hereby determined.

A. To Ormoc City

-All passenger busses, vans, multicabs and jeepneys whose passeger(s) have cargoes to be picked up from the business establishments which are located outside the designated exit route are allowed to deviate only to pick up cargoes, provided, a pass slip is issued by the Office of the Traffic Enforcer, at the Bus Terminal area. For this purpose, the pass slip shall indicate the alternate route to be taken by the vehicles in going back to the exit route.

B. To Maasin City-

from the Bus Terminal, to the Tres Martires St., and Magsaysay Ave.

- C. To Tacloban City-will pass through Tres Martires St., M.L. Quezon St., and E. Jacinto St.
- D. From Ormoc City to the Bus Terminal:
 - d. 1. All public utility vehicle will pass through the A. Mabini St., to the Reclamation road then to Bus Terminal from Monday to Saturday; on Sunday and Church Holidays they will pass through the A. Mabini St. to Magsaysay Ave., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal. However, passenger busses, vans, multicabs or jeepneys maybe allowed to deviate from their entry route only for the purpose of transporting student passengers to their respective school.
 - d. 2. Multicabs, Tricycles and Habal-habal shall pass through A. Mabini St., N.L. Fernandez St., A. Bonifacio St., or through A. Mabini St., G.H. del Pilar St., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal.
- E. From Maasin City to the Bus Terminal:
 - Magsaysay Ave., right turn E. Jacinto St., and left turn to 30 de Deciembre St., to A. Mabini St. to Terminal.
- From Tacloban City to the Bus Terminal:
 - f. 1. All public utility buses, vans, multicabs and jeepneys will pass through the E. Jacinto St., turn right to 30 de Deciembre St., turn left to A. Mabini St., to the reclamation area to the Bus



- SECTION 3. The line route as designated by this proposed ordinance are hereby determined.
- A. To Ormoc City for Passenger Bus Only from the Terminal passing through the Tres Martires St., 30 de Deciembre St., and A. Mabini St.
 - All passenger busses, vans, multicabs and jeepneys whose passenger(s) have cargoes to be picked up from the business establishments which are located outside the designated exit route are allowed to deviate only pick up cargoes, provided, a pass slip is issued by the Office of the Traffic Enforcer, at the Bus Terminal area. For this purpose, the pass slip shall indicate the alternate route to be taken by the vehicles in going back to the exit route.
- B. To Maasin City from the Bus Terminal, to the Tres Martires St., and Magsaysay Ave.
- C. To Tacloban City will pass through Tres Martires St., M.L.Quezon St., and E. Jacinto St.
- D. From Ormoc City to the Bus Terminal:
 - d.1. All public utility vehicle will pass through the A. Mabini St., to the Reclamation road then to Bus Terminal from Monday to Saturday; on Sunday and Church Holidays they will pass through the A. Mabini St. To Magsaysay Ave., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal. However, passenger busses, vans, multicabs or jeepneys maybe allowed to deviate from their entry route only for the purpose of transporting student passengers to their respective school.
 - d. 2. Multicabs, Tricycles and Habal-habal shall pass through A. Mabini St., N. L. Fernandez St., A. Bonifacio St., or through A. Mabini St., G. H. Del Pilar St., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal.
- E. From Maasin City to the Bus Terminal:
 - e. 1. Magsaysay Ave., right turn E. Jacinto St., and left turn to 30 de Deciembre St., to A. Mabini St., to Terminal.
- F. From Tacloban City to the Bus Terminal:
 - f. 1. All public utility buses, vans, multicabs and jeepneys will pass through the E. Jacinto St., turn right to 30 de Deciembre St., turn left to A. Mabini St., to the reclamation area.

Multicabs, tricycles, & Habal-habal will pass through E. Jacinto St., 30 de Deciembre St., Tres Martires St., Magsaysay Ave., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal.

SECTION 4 - Unloading areas of passengers and cargoes before arriving at the Bus Terminal

A. From Ormoc City- All public utility vehicles can unload passengers and cargoes at designated areas along A. Mabini St., and N. L. Fernandez; A. Mabini St., and G.H. del pilar St., A. Mabini St., and Magsaysay Ave., or at the reclamation area.

- B. Multicabs, tricycles and Habal-habal can unload passengers and cargoes at designated areas along A. Mabini St., and N. L. Fernandez St., A. Bonifacio St. and N. L. Fernandez St., and near the Caltex Station.
- C. From Maasin City -All Public utility vehicles can unload passenger and cargoes along E. Jacinto St., and Magsaysay Ave., along the street area of Zone 22 and 30 de Deciembre St.
- D.. From Tacloban City All utility vehicles can unload passenger and cargoes along E. Jacinto St and 30 de Deciembre St., and near the Oriental Store.

SECTION 5 Enforcement Period -

This ordinance shall be enforced between 6:00 am -to 7:00 pm.

SECTION 6 - Prohibited Acts -

It shall be considered as a violation of this Ordinance of a public utility vehicle driver, conductor, dispatcher or any other person authorized by any operator or his representative to solicit or accept passengers, cargoes and allow them to board their public utility vehicles in any place of the poblacion (Zone 1-23) of Baybay other than Bus Terminal except the picking up of passengers in the course of their route towards their respective destinations outside of the poblacion (Zone 1-23) proper.

SECTION 7 - Penalty

Violators of any provision of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum of P700 for Bus, P500 for jeepneys, multicab and V-Hire vans and P100 for tricycle and Habalhabal for the first offense;

Second offense - the same amount shall be collected as fine, suspension of franchise permit and the privilege to use the facility of the Bus Terminal, for tricycle, and for all other public utility vehicles suspension of the privilege to use the Bus Terminal for one day;

Third offense - any violator after the second offense shall be called habitua violators and shall be imposed the following penalty:

A. Bus -P2,000 plus suspension of their privilege to use the terminal facility for one week and five (5) days imprisonment for the driver & conductor

- B. Jeepneys, vans -P1,000 plus suspension of their privilege to use the terminal facility for one week and three (3) days imprisonment for the driver.
- C. Tricycle & Habal-habal P500 plus suspension of their privilege to use the terminal facility for one week and three (3) days imprisonment for the driver.

The primary person liable to pay the fine is the registered owner or operator of the public utility vehicle except if the violator is not employed or crew of the latter and in such a case the violator himself is liable to pay the fine as provided in first paragraph hereof..

SECTION 7 - Separability Clause

If any portion or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid it shall not invalidate the whole ordinance.

SECTION 8 - Repealing Clause

All existing ordinances, rules and regulations, which are inconsistent to this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified.

SECTION 9- EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after its approval.
