

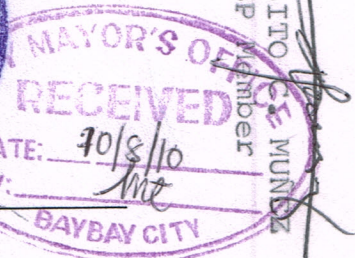

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 006 S. 2010

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF MARKET STALLS/BOOTH TIENDAS PER SQ.
METERS AND OTHER FEES WITHIN THE PUBLIC MARKET OF THE CITY OF BAYBAY.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City Government of Baybay
that:

SECTION 1.- Definitions – When used in this Article.

Public Market refers to any place, building or structure of any kind, designated as such
by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

Market Premises refer to any space in the market compound; part of the market lot
consisting of bare ground, not covered by market buildings, usually occupied by transient
vendors especially during market days.

Market Section refers to a subdivision of the market, housing one class or group of
allied goods, commodities, or merchandise.

SECTION 2- Market Sections. – For purposes of this section, the Public market of
Baybay City, Leyte shall be divided as follows:

1. Fish Section - Fresh fish, clams, oysters, lobsters, shrimps seaweeds, and
other sea foods or marine products.
2. Meat section - Fresh meat from cow, carabao, horse, goat, sheep, swine and
fowls.
3. Dry goods Section - All kinds of textiles ready-made dresses and apparels,
toiletries, novelties, shoes, laces, kitchen wares, handbags, bags, school and
office supplies.
4. Grocery and Sari-sari Store section - All kinds of cakes, butter, cheese,
confectioneries, candles, canned or bottled foods, beverages, salt, drinks,
flour, rice, oatmeal, ham, bacon sugar, nuts, sauce, onions, garlic potatoes,
eggs, toilet articles, sausages, corn, mongo, starch, smoked fish, dried fish,
salt, soap and other household or food products, including firewood and
charcoal.
5. Vegetables and Fruit Section - All kinds of vegetables, fruits, and root
crops.
6. Eateries and Cooked Food Section - All kinds of cooked food, including
refreshments and cakes
7. Poultry Products Section - Chickens, ducks, birds, duckling or piglets

The numbering designation, classification or other form of identifying market
section shall be the responsibility of the City Treasurer.

SECTION 3.- Imposition of Fees – There shall be collected the following market fees.**A. Rental for fixed stall/booth/tiendas, per square meter or fraction thereof:**

Market Section	Rental
1. Fish Section/Stall	P 650 per month
2. Meat Section/stall	P 750 per month
3. Vegetable and Fruit Section	P 400 per month
4. Grocery and Rice & Corn	P 1,500 per month
5. Eating Place	P 750 per month
6. Poultry Products Section (dressed chicken)	P 750 per month
7. Booking Office	P 2,500 per stall

The above rates shall be increased by 25% for corner stalls/booths/tiendas or those fronting.

B. Fee for occupancy of market premises	P 10.00/sq. m per day
Parking fee (Commodity Peddling Truck)	P 20.00 per day
Commodity Entrance Fee	P 50.00 per truck delivery
Parking Fee for all Vehicles	P 10.00 per parking

SECTION 3.- Market Entrance Fee – In lieu of the regular market fees based on the space occupied, there is hereby imposed a market entrance fee of any commodity or merchandising being brought into the Baybay Public Market, at the following rates.

Rice/corn	P 5.00 per sack
Mangoes, per Kaing (ripe/green)	P 10.00 per kaing
Coconut, per sack (for grated purposes)	P 5.00 per sack
Chicken/Entrills	P 5.00 per crate
Fresh Eggs	P 5.00 per box
Hot dog	P 5.00 per box
Peanuts, per sack (unshelled)	P 10.00 per sack
Peanuts, per sack (shelled)	P 20.00 per sack
Fresh Fish	P 10.00 per 50 kls/or box
Salted Fish (guinamos)	P 5.00 per bag/bayong
Salted Fish (tinabal)	P 10.00 per bag
Vegetables	P 10 per bakat
Sea Weeds (goso)	P 5.00 per sack
Tahong	P 10.00 per sack
Dried Fish per box	P 5.00/box @ 20 kg.
Dried fish,	P 10.00 per bakat
Charcoal	P 5.00 per sack
Camote	P 5.00 per sack
Banana	P 5.00 per sack
Fire wood	P 5.00 per bundle

In case the vendor from whom, an entrance fee was collected occupies any table, cubicle or other space with area in excess of what he paid for, he shall be required to pay the correct amount of fee due thereon less what he may have already paid as entrance fee.

Duly licensed suppliers or distributors of goods, commodities or merchandise to replenish or augment their stock, shall not be considered as transient vendors required to pay the market entrance fees herein authorized and the appropriate surcharged.

SECTION 4.- This ordinance shall be introduced to update the actual collection of the services within the public market.
