MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 004 S. 2001

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TIME OF DISPENSING AND/ OR SELLING OF LIQUOR WINE AND OTHER ALCOHOLIC DRINKS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Baybay, Province of Leyte, in session assembled, that:

Rationale:

The maintenance of peace and order is one of the prime concerns of the local government of Baybay henceforth, it has to curve down the criminality in our municipality. Observation disclosed that most of the crimes are committed during the wee hours in the morning between 12:00 Midnight-4:00 a.m. for those persons who have been intoxicated with liquors, wine and other alcoholic drinks.

It is for this main reason that dispensing of such alcoholic drinks shall therefore be regulated to avoid or minimize criminality in our municipality.

SECTION 1. <u>TITLE OF THE ORDINANCE</u> - The title of this ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Regulating the time of Dispensing and/or selling of Liquor, wine and other Alcoholic Drinks and providing penalties for violations thereof".

SECTION 2. - DEFINITION OF TERMS -

- a. Liquor Any alcoholic beverage especially distilled spirits such as whisky brandy and rum;
- Wine any fermented juice of some fruits containing various percentages of alcohol by volume commonly used as beverage and often classified as dry or sweet, red or white, still or sparkling;

- c. Other Alcoholic drinks any other drinks, containing a certain percentage of alcohol that can intoxicate the drinker;
- d. Dispensing to give or deal out in portion...
- e. Actual dispenser a person who gives out or administers or deals out liquor, wine and other alcoholic drinks;
- f. Actual receiver a person who receives or is a recepient of the liquor, wine and other intoxicating drinks.
- g. Sale the act of selling or the actual exchange or transfer of money into its equivalent as the liquor, wine and other alcoholic drinks.
- h. Actual seller means person or who actually dispense or sell liquor, wine and other alcoholic drinks and actually received payment or arranged credit for the same.
- Actual buyer means person or persons who actually pay or arranged credit for the liquor, wine and other alcoholic drinks dispensed with by the actual seller.

SECTION 3. - No person or person are allowed to dispense or sell liquor, wine, and other alcoholic drinks beyond 12:00 midnight until 4:00 a.m. of the same day to any person.

SECTION 4. - Mandatory posting of the salient feature of this Ordinance is required upon the owner of the establishment, violation of which shall mean cancellation of the Mayors Permit previously issued to them.

SECTION 5. - <u>Penalty Clause</u> - Both the actual seller or dispenser of a business establishment and the actual buyer or receiver found violating this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

Ist Offense - P500.00 each to both the actual sellere or dispenser and the actual buyer or receiver

2nd Offense - Closure of the establishment and imprisonment of both the actual seller and the actual buyer of not more than 3 months upon conviction at the discretion of the court

SECTION 6. - Repealing Clause - All related ordinances not consistent with this ordinance is herby repealed and or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7 - Effectivity - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
