## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 004s. 2004

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PIG RAISING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYBAY, LEYTE

(SPONSORED & INTRO. BY: SBM MANUEL A. CHAN AND SBM MICHAEL L. CARI)

SECTION 1. **Title** - This ordinance shall be known as the "Pig Raising' within the Municipality of Baybay, Leyte..

SECTION 2. **Declaration of Policies** - It is hereby declared the policy of Baybay, Leyte to adopt a systematic and ecological waste management program on all piggery projects. To ensure the protection of public health and the environment To have an effective implementation of the Rules and Regulations. "Nuisances and Offensive Trade & Occupations of the code on Sanitation of the Philippines" (P.D. 856).

SECTION 3. Coverage - This ordinance shall apply to all pig raising projects, whether for personal consumption, backyard raising, or for commercial purposes, to all barangays within Baybay, Leyte.

SECTION 4. Objective or Purpose - This ordinance shall served as the legal or policy framework for the management of hogwaste and cleanliness of the piggery projects. to comply with Presidential Decree 856 "Code on Sanitation of the Philippines".

## SECTION 5. Definition of Terms.-

**Piggery Projects** - refers to the raising or breeding of pigs or swine for personal or commercial purposes.

Backyard Piggery - refers to 1-4 sq. meters pig pens of swine for whatever purpose only.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PIG RAISING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYBAY, LEYTE

SECTION 1. Title - This ordinance shall be known as the "Pig Raising' within the Municipality of Baybay, Leyte..

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policies - It is hereby declared the policy of Baybay, Leyte to adopt a systematic and ecological waste management program on all piggery projects. To ensure the protection of public health and the environment To have an effective implementation of the Rules and Regulations. "Nuisances and Offensive Trade & Occupations of the code on Sanitation of the Philippines" (P.D. 856).

SECTION 3. Coverage - This ordinance shall apply to all pig raising projects, whether for personal consumption, backyard raising, or for commercial purposes, to all barangays within Baybay, Leyte.

SECTION 4. Objective or Purpose - This ordinance shall served as the legal or policy framework for the management of hogwaste and cleanliness of the piggery projects, to comply with Presidential Decree 856 "Code on Sanitation of the Philippines".

#### SECTION 5. Definition of Terms,-

Piggery Projects - refers to the raising or breeding of pigs or swine for personal or commercial purposes.

Backyard Piggery - refers to 1-4 sq. meters pig pens of swine for whatever purpose only.

Medium Scale Piggery - maximum of 4.1 to 8 sq. meters pig pens only either personal or commercial purposes.

Piggery Farms/Large Scale Piggery - refers to any parcel of land devoted to raising or breeding of pigs for commercial purposes, from 8.1 sq. meters pig pens and above.

ECC- refers to Environment Compliance Certificate Issued by Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) of the Department of Environment & Natural Resources (DENR).

**Proponent** - refers to the owner of the piggery project generally under the management of a tenant or owner.

Pre-operation Phase - refers to the requirement needed before the implementation of the project.

Operation Phase - refers to the requirements when the project starts its implementation or operation, which will be maintain by the owner during its day to day operation.

SECTION 6. - **Pre-Operation Phase** - Pre-requisite requirements on all piggery project for Permit/Clearances before operation including all existing piggery projects without the necessary permits.

## A. Backyard and Medium:

- Barangay Resolution or Clearance interposing no objection to the project;
- 2. Clearance from Municipal Engineer as to the building construction and septic tank.
- Sanitary Permit from Rural Health Unit where the project is located.

## B. Large Scale Piggery:

- Barangay Resolution or Clearance interposing no objection to the project.
- 2. Clearance from Municipal Engineer as to the building construction and septic tank.
- 4. SB Resolution interposing no objection to the project.
- Environmental Coimpliance Certificate (ECC) from DENR or Non-coverage application for ECC for those classified as backyard piggery and not for commercial quantity (ECC is not required on medium scale piggery)
- 6. Mayor's Permit to operate or business permit from the Local Chief Executive.

SECTION 7. - Operation Phase - Specific requirements for compulsory compliance to require all piggery within Baybay Leyte whether backyard piggery for personal consumption or piggery farms for commercial purposes.

- 1. To have sufficient water supply;
- 2. Drainage system
- 3. Maintain state of sanitation;
- No obnoxious odor or smeel that would adversely affect the neighbors;
- No proliferation of flies that will arise as a source of nuisance in day to day operation.
- 6. To provide an appropriate septic tank for hog waste disposal.

SECTION 8. Any violation of the specific requirements under Section 7 shall be sufficient ground for revocation or suspension of the Business or Mayor's Permit.

SECTION 9. The requirements under Section 6 (Pre-Operation Phase) are renewable every year to ensure compliance; except on ECC from DENR.

SECTION 10. Septic Tank Construction that will produce bio-gas which is available at LSU, Research Department, are optional on backyard and medium scale piggery projects but are required on piggery farms for large scale purposes to ensure its sanitation.

SECTION 11. That the Local Chief Executive may provide mechanics of the implementing rules and regulations for the detailed implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 12. **Penalty Clause** - any person violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction be fined om the amount of P1,000.00 - P2,5000.00 or imprisonment of 7-15 days or both upon the discretion of the court.

SECTION 13. Repealing Clause - This ordinance repeals all preceding ordinances regulation piggery projects in Baybay, Leyte.

SECTION 14. Severity of Provisions - If any or more provisions of this ordinance shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality or enforceability of the remaining provisions contained therein shall not in anyway affect or impaired the whole provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 15. Effectivity- This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval after and publication.
