WHEREAS, there is only one government hospital, the Western Leyte Provincial Hospital (WLPH) that caters medication to patients of different serious health problems, including those coming from the neighboring municipalities of the 5th District of Leyte;

WHEREAS, there have been several instances of emergency cases when physicians have to do referrals of severe patients to certain hospitals in Tacloban City, but were a little bit delayed due to simultaneous using of ambulance units available.




RESOLVED FURTHER, that certified copies of this resolution be furnished to all agencies and offices concerned for their information and appropriate action.


