## RESOLUTION NO. 44, S. 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE CARMEN L. CARI TO CREATE THE BAYBAY CITY BLOOD COUNCIL AND TO APPOINT THE MEMBERS CONSTITUTING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Baybay supports Republic Act 7719, otherwise known as the National Blood Services Act of 1994, a national law that promotes and encourages voluntary blood donation by the citizenry and to instill public consciousness of the principle that blood donation is a humanitarian act;

WHEREAS, the creation of this council intends to render noble services for the constituents of this city in terms of helping patients who need blood transfusion;

WHEREAS, the existence of the Baybay City Blood Council strengthens the linkages of local hospitals, facilities providing emergency obstetric care and health services with the Blood Centers,

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable SP Member Vicente Victor G. Veloso, and duly seconded by Honorable SP Members Leoncio P. Asilom, Jr., Dominador K. Murillo and Alan D. Fernandez, be it;

RESOLVED, as it hereby does RESOLVE, to authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Carmen L. Cari to create the Baybay City Blood Council and to appoint the members constituting thereto.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that certified copies of this resolution be furnished to all offices and agencies concerned for their information and appropriate action.
