RESOLUTION NO. 001

A RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE CONDONING PRIOR YEARS' PENALTIES ON UNPAID REAL PROPERTY TAXES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYBAY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Presented for deliberation was unpaid real property taxes and the desire of the municipallity to intensify its collection on these properties.

On motion of the Honorable SB Member Manuel A. Chan, duly seconded by the Honorable SB Members Edgardo R. Ompoy and Deogracias E. Pernitez; be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, that the following municipal ordinance, as hereby is adopted to wit:

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 001-s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE CONDONING PRIOR YEARS' PENALTIES ON UNPAID REAL PROPERTY TAXES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYBAY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Baybay Province of Leyle, in session assembled, that:

Section 1.- <u>Definition of Terms</u> - The following words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall, for the purposes thereof, have the meaning as respectively ascribed to them:

Condonation - As used in this ordinance, shall mean the forgiving, or reduction, of any amount added to the basic real property tax whether, in the form of a surcharge or interest. It shall be synonymous to Amnesty.

Real Property- As used in this ordinance, shall mean the land owned by the taxpayer including any improvement thereon subject to tax.

- As used in this ordinance, shall mean the public sale of property to the highest bidder.

Basic Real Property Tax - As used in this ordinance, shall mean the unit value of the property based on classification and schedule of market valueas determined by the assessors.

Amnesty

 For purpose of this ordinance shall mean granting of pardon on interest and surcharges on Real Property Tax on all delinquent years.

Section 2. <u>Purpose</u> - This ordinance shall govern the manner by which prior years' penalties in unpaid real property tax is granted to unburden the taxpayer from paying any surcharge or interest other than the basic tax on real property, increase taxpayer's ability to comply with governmental flat as well as boost the local government's ability to increase collection on real property taxes.

Section 3. - This ordinance is an amendment of Mun. Ordinance No. 97-002 dated March 18, 997.

Section 4.- Coverage - The Condonation of penalty shall be extended to all real property owners and lawfull possessor whether individual or juridical, with delinquent real property tax, who shall, including the current year, pay in full all basic real property taxes levied, free of surcharges and interest. Partial and staggered payments of basic real property taxes due shall qualify for amnesty, provided it should be paid within a period of six(6) months starting upon final approval of this ordinance.

All penalties due on real properties on all prior years are hereby condoned, including interest surcharges due on a previously registered and unregistered properties should the owner of such real property desire or wanted to avail of the amnesty.

Section 5. - <u>Period of Coverage</u> - the period of coverage of this tax ordinance shall be six (6) months from the final approval of this ordinance.

Section 6. - Repealing clause - Any order or issuance which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. Effectiviity Clause - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
