RESOLUTION NO. 40

A RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL FLOWER,
MOTTO AND SEAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYBAY, LEYTE, DELINEATING
AND/OR DEFINING THEIR MEANINGS OR SIGNIFICANCE, AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, this Body was great^{ly} flabbergasted to know of late
that the municipality has no official flower, motto and seal yet;
and

WHEREAS, this Body humbly believes that it is now an oppor-
tune time to adopt, as a course of action, the municipality's
official seal and flower as well as its befitting motto.

WHEREFORE, on Motion of the Honorable SB Member Dominador
L. Chiong, duly seconded by the rest of the SB members present;
be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the following muni-
cipal ordinance be, as hereby is, adopted, to wit:

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL FLOWER, MOTTO AND SEAL OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF BAYBAY, LEYTE, DELINEATING AND/OR DEFINING THEIR
MEANINGS OR SIGNIFICANCE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality
of Baybay, Province of Leyte, in session assembled, that:

Section 1. - Title and Scope. - this ordinance shall be known
as an ordinance adopting the official flower, motto and seal of
the Municipality of Baybay, Leyte, delineating and/or defining
their meanings or significance, and for other purposes.

Section 2. - Adoption, as a Course of Action. - the presented
draft of the proposed seal which was refined thrice, flower "rosal"
and the edage or expressive sentence "One Country, One Constitution,
One Destiny" are hereby adopted as the official seal, flower and
motto of the Municipality of Baybay, Leyte.

Section 3. - Meanings, Purposes and Definitions. - "Rosal" has been chosen as the official flower of the municipality the fact that it abounds or grows luxuriantly in the town, while the aphorism or apothegm adverted to is deemed to be proper and fitting to a place like Baybay, and the symbols and/or objects in the adopted seal are hereby defined, to wit:

- a - the monument towering at the center symbolizes the oneness as well as the strength and sturdiness of the Baybayenons.
- b - the somewhat a tree is the plant "rosal" which typifies the flair of the inhabitants of the municipality for music and acting.
- c - the sailboat at the background represents the territorial waters of the municipality abounds with marine life.
- d - the rising sun at the background indicates the ingenuity and skillfulness of the Baybayenons.
- e - the chains encircling the seal represents the 92 barangays of the municipality having unity and mutual understanding.


Section 4. - Necessity - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
