MUNICIPAL DRDINANCE NO. 97-004

HON. JOSE CARLOS L. CARI

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL DISPATCHERS AND PORTERS IN THE MUNI-CIPALITY OF BAYBAY, LEYTE TO WEAR UNIFORMS WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

:INTRODUCED AND SPONSORED BY SBMs F.M. CAYUNDA & Z.A. PURAY :

WHEREAS, it is the rich desire of this Sanggunian to have the dispatchers and porters a sheer distinction from the plain or ordinary citizens for obvious reason, more especially in the pier and terminals for vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is but proper and fitting to prevent any activity which is inimical to the welfare of the citizenry,

NOW, THEREFORE

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Baybay, Province of Leyte, in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Definition of terms -

- a. Dispatcher means any person who dispatches or who directs the movements of any public utility vehicle, such as the buses, jeepneys, tricycles, multicabs, and the like.
- b. Porter means one who carries things; especially, a man who carries travelers baggage, etc., for, as in a wharf or at bus station.
- C. Uniform means being the same or alike, as in form, appearance, quality, quantity, color, or character.

Section 2. It is unlawful for any Baybay dispatcher or porter who is on duty not to wear their proper complete uniform.

Section 3. Uniform - must have the name of the dispatcher or porter wearing, and a number at the back and front of the T-shirt, with the printed words "Baybay Dispatcher" or "Baybay Porter".

Section 4. Penalty - to any dispatcher or porter who violates this ordinance shall be penalized by a fine of One Hundred Pesos (\$100.00), for the first offense; and for the second offense shall be fined of Two Hundred Pesos (\$200.00); and for the third offense is the cancellation of his license as a dispatcher or porter.

Dispatcher or porter who is penalized by a fine of \$\frac{1}{200.00}\$ of \$\frac{2}{200.00}\$, as the case may be, herein above-mentioned and would not pay the said amount, would ipso facto, be suspended from his duty as dispatcher or porter.

Section 5. Repealing Clause - any resolution or ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days upon its approval.
