EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 52

March 17, 2020

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL MEASURES TO
PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 IN THE CITY OF BAYBAY**

WHEREAS, in accordance with the pronouncement of the President of the Republic of the Philippines and the World Health Organization (WHO) declaring the recent Coronavirus event as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern, there is a need that all residents of the City should comply with the policy on social distancing and home quarantine to contain and/or mitigate the effect of Covid-19 virus;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 49 and 50 Series of 2020 issued by the City Mayor, after consultation with the Inter-Agency Task Force on Covid-19, prescribed the guidelines on the precautionary measures that every person residing in the City must perform to contain the entry or spread of the Coronavirus in the City of Baybay;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 03-2020-03 Series 200 issued by the Provincial Governor has placed the entire Leyte Province under General Community Quarantine and enjoin all Local Government Units within the Province of Leyte to enhance its measures against Covid-19;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE CARLOS L. CARI, City Mayor of Baybay City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following;

1. The entry of persons by sea shall be prohibited from March 18, 2020 until April 17, 2020 except the following;
 - a. Those who are residents of Baybay City, provided that proof of residency shall be presented upon entry;
 - b. Those who are residents outside of Baybay City but who have work, business or is self-employed within the territorial subdivision of Baybay City, provided that proof of employment or business registration shall be presented upon entry;
 - c. Students who reside outside of Baybay City provided proof of enrollment shall be presented upon entry;

- d. Members of the PNP, Military and Health Personnel;
2. All internet cafes shall be temporarily closed during the period mentioned above in order to encourage students to stay home.
3. The private sector is strongly encouraged to enforce additional measures in its workplaces such as close monitoring of employees, flexible working time, thermal scanners, and provisions of alcohols or hand sanitizers at the entry/exit points of the establishments.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
