ORDINANCE NO. 20, SERIES 2020

“AN ORDINANCE NAMING A SUBDIVISION OF BARANGAY ZONE 18, BAYBAY CITY, AS “SITIO VERDE”

WHEREAS, Section 13 of the Local Government Code (RA 7610) provides that the Sanggunians of component cities and municipalities may change the name of the city or municipal barangays, upon recommendation of the Sangguniang barangay concerned;

WHEREAS, Barangay Zone 18 passed a resolution requesting for the naming of a subdivision within their territorial jurisdiction as Sitio Verde after a consultation was done with the residents of the subject place;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Jose Rommel A. Peñaranda, and duly seconded by Honorable Filemon F. Avila,

BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* of the City of Baybay, Province of Leyte, in its Regular Session held on March 26, 2020 duly assembled, to wit:

Section 1. Title: This ordinance shall be known as “AN ORDINANCE NAMING A SUBDIVISION OF BARANGAY ZONE 18, BAYBAY CITY, AS “SITIO VERDE”, or the Sitio Verde Ordinance

Section 2. Topographic Location. A subdivision situated within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Zone 18 shall be named as “Sitio Verde”. It is located on the interior portion of Barangay Zone 18 with an access road along 30 de Diciembre Street, Baybay City.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. – Pertinent provisions of all other laws, decrees, executive orders and rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 4. Separability Clause.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared separable and if any provision shall be held invalid, or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions hereof are not affected and shall remain valid and effective.


Section 5. Effectivity.

This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon its publication or after due compliance with all the requirements provided under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.


