CITY ORDINANCE NO. 08, S-2021

(Sponsored by Honorable Ramon Ronald J. Veloso)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 005, S. 2008, ESTABLISHING LINE ROUTE OF ALL PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF BAYBAY, PARTICULARLY SECTION 3 AND SECTION 4 ONLY.

On motion of Honorable Ramon Ronald J. Veloso, and duly seconded by Honorable Rodulfo S. Palma, Jr. and Honorable Philip L. Siu;

BE IT ORDAINED by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled on February 24, 2021 at the Session Hall, Legislative Building, this city, an ordinance is hereby adopted, to wit:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 005, S. 2008, ESTABLISHING LINE ROUTE OF ALL PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF BAYBAY, PARTICULARLY SECTION 3 AND SECTION 4 ONLY.

SECTION 2. PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

From:

SECTION 3 – The line route as designated by this proposed ordinance are hereby determined.

A. To Ormoc City – All passenger busses, vans, multicabs and jeepneys whose passenger(s) have cargoes to be picked up from the business establishments which are located outside the designated exit route are allowed to deviate only to pick up cargoes, provided a pass slip is issued by the Office of the Traffic Enforcer, at the Bus Terminal Area. For this purpose, the pass slip shall indicate the alternate route to be taken by the vehicles in going back to the exit route.

B. To Maasin City – from the Bus Terminal, to the Tres Martires St., and Magsaysay Ave.

C. To Tacloban City – will pass through Tres Martires St., M.L. Quezon St., and E. Jacinto St.

D. From Ormoc City to the Bus Terminal:

d.1. All public utility will pass through the A. Mabini St., to the Reclamation road then to Bus Terminal from Monday to Saturday; on

Sunday and Church Holidays they will pass through A. Mabini St., to Magsaysay Ave., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal. However, passenger busses, vans, multicabs or jeepneys maybe allowed to deviate from their entry route only for the purpose of transporting student passengers to their respective school.

d.2 Multicabs, tricycles and Habal-habal shall pass through A. Mabini St., N.L. Fernandez St., A. Bonifacio St., or through A. Mabini St., G. H. del Pilar St., A. bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal.

E. From Maasin City to the Bus Terminal:

e.1 Magsaysay Ave., right turn E. Jacinto St., and left turn to 30 de Diciembre St., to A. Mabini St. to Terminal.

F. From Tacloban City to the Bus Terminal:

f.1 All public utility buses, vans, multicabs and jeepneys will pass through the E. Jacinto St., turn right to 30 de Diciembre St., turn left to A. Mabini St., to the reclamation area to the Bus Terminal from Monday to Saturday; on Sunday they will pass through the E. Jacinto St., 30 de Diciembre St., A. Mabini St., Magsaysay Ave., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal.

f.2 Multicabs, tricycles, & habal – habal will pass through E. Jacinto St., 30 de Diciembre St., Tres Martires St., Magsaysay Ave., A. Bonifacio St., to the Bus Terminal.

TO:

SECTION 3. The line route as designated by this proposed ordinance are hereby determined.

A. West - North Route (Baybay – Maybog)

a. 1 Present Public Terminal – Boulevard – Tres Martires St. – 30 de Diciembre St. – A. Mabini St. (National Highway Cogon) – Candadam – Sta. Cruz – Kilim – Gabas – Guadalupe – Pangasugan – Marcos – San Agustin – Bunga – Hilapnitan – Caridad – Maybog.

B. West – South Route (Baybay – Plaridel)

b.1 Present Public Terminal – Boulevard – M. Moraza St. – R. Magsaysay St. – (National Highway) Hipusngo – Palhi – Sabang – Jaena – Punta – Maitum – Bitanhuan – Maslug – Plaridel.

C. West – East Route (Baybay – Villa Solidaridad)

c.1 Present Public Terminal – Boulevard – M. Moraza St., - M.L. Quezon St., (National Highway) Gaas – Buenavista – Imelda – Makinhas – Gubang – Kambonggan – Higuluan Monteverde – Mailhi – Villa Solidaridad

D. North – West Route (Maybog – Baybay)

d.1 (National Highway) Cogon – A. Mabini St. – R. Magsaysay – A. Bonifacio – Present Public Terminal.

E. South – West Route (Plaridel – Baybay)

e.1 (National Highway) Hipusngo – R. Magsaysay St. – A. Bonifacio St. – Present Public Terminal

F. East – West Route (Villa Solidaridad – Baybay)

f.1 (National Highway) Gaas – E. Jacinto St. – R. Magsaysay St. - Present Public Terminal.

G. Circular Floating Route

g.1 Present Public Terminal – Magsaysay Avenue – New South Terminal – Hipusngo Diversion Road – New North Terminal – North National Highway – Present Public Terminal.

SECTION 4 – Unloading areas of passengers and cargoes before arriving at the Bus Terminal

FROM:

A. From Ormoc City – All public utility vehicles shall unload passengers and cargoes at designated areas along A. Mabini St., and N. L. Fernandez St., A. Bonifacio St., A. Mabini St., and G. H del Pilar St., A. Mabini St., and Magsaysay Ave., or at the Reclamation area.

B. Multicabs, tricycles and Habal-habal shall unload passengers and cargoes at designated areas along A. Mabini St., and N.L. Fernandez St., A. Bonifacio St., and N. L. Fernandez St., and near the Caltex Station.

C. From Maasin City – All Public utility vehicles shall unload passenger and cargoes along E. Jacinto St., and Magsaysay Ave., along the street area of Zone 22 and 30 de Diciembre St.

D. From – Tacloban City – All Utility vehicles shall unload passenger and cargoes along E. Jacinto St and 30 de Diciembre St., and near the Oriental Store.

TO:

Unloading areas of passengers and cargoes before arriving at the Bus Terminal -

A. All PUV's shall unload passengers and cargoes only at designated unloading/loading areas, to wit:

a-1. Palermo Hotel - Unloading North (In-bound);

b-2. New Building in front of Palermo Hotel - Loading North (Outbound);

b-3. Petron/ Esquina – Unloading East and South (both in-bound and outbound);

b-4. LEYECO – Unloading/loading from East (both in-bound and outbound).

SECTION 3. APPLICABILITY

This ordinance applies to all Public Utility Vehicles (PUV's) except tricycles, Pot-pots and all other vehicles with registrations issued by the City Government.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is held in valid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. Pertinent provisions of all other laws, ordinances, executive orders and rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after due compliance with all the requirements provided for under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.
